1 moves to amend the bill on page 18, lines 37-38, by inserting between those lines the following
2 new section to read:

3 **"EUGENICS COMPENSATION PAYMENTS**

4 **SECTION 6.12.** G.S. 143B-426.51 reads as rewritten:

5 **§ 143B-426.51. Compensation payments.**

6 (a) A claimant determined to be a qualified recipient under this Part shall receive
7 compensation in the amount determined by this subsection from funds appropriated for these
8 purposes. A qualified recipient shall receive compensation in the form of ~~two~~three payments.
9 By October 31, 2014, claimants determined by the Commission to be qualified recipients shall
10 receive an initial payment as provided by this section. Claimants determined to be qualified
11 recipients after that date shall receive an initial payment within 60 days of the Commission's
12 determination. A second ~~and payment shall be made as provided for in this section.~~ A final
13 payment shall be made after the exhaustion of all appeals arising from the denial of eligibility
14 for compensation under this Part.

15 The initial payment to each qualified recipient will be calculated by adding together the
16 number of qualified recipients as of October 1, 2014, and the number of claims outstanding that
17 are pending, then dividing that total number into the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000).
18 The initial payment checks shall be remitted by October 31, 2014.

19 The second payment of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) shall be made to each qualified
20 recipient who is determined to be eligible for compensation as of June 1, 2015. The second
21 payment checks shall be remitted by July 1, 2015.

22 The final payment calculation will be made by taking the balance of compensation funds
23 remaining after the exhaustion of appeals and dividing that sum equally between the number of
24 qualified recipients determined finally to be eligible to receive compensation. The final
25 payment checks shall be remitted within 90 days of the exhaustion of the last appeal. Any
26 qualified claimant who was successful on appeal and who did not receive an initial payment or
27 second payment shall be paid an amount equal to the initial and second payment amount,
28 amounts, plus the amount from the final payment calculation, and less the amount
29 of any compensation previously received pursuant to this section.

30 The Office and the State Controller shall collaborate to facilitate the administration of this
31 section so as to effectuate the compensation of qualified recipients as soon as practicable.
