CHAPTER 1098  
HOUSE BILL 990

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF THE BUDGET TO MAKE TRANSFERS  
2 FROM PRISON DEPARTMENT PROJECTS FOR WHICH CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT  
3 APPROPRIATIONS WERE MADE IN 1963 AND FROM RECEIPTS FROM THE SALE  
4 OF PRISON LAND TO PERMIT CONSTRUCTION OF A 250-MAN PRISON TO  
5 REPLACE THE BURKE COUNTY UNIT AND A 250-MAN PRISON TO REPLACE  
6 CRAGGY PRISON.

8 WHEREAS, Craggy Prison was constructed more than forty years ago as a county  
9 prison and is so designed and so located that long range economies, operational efficiency, and  
10 adequate provisions for future development made more feasible construction of a new 250-man  
11 unit to replace Craggy Prison; and

12 WHEREAS, decreases in the need for inmates on road work have made unnecessary  
13 expansion of the Greene County Prison Unit and enabled the Prison Department to make use of  
14 the Halifax County Unit for inmates working at Caledonia Prison eliminating the need for an  
15 additional 100-man dormitory there; and

16 WHEREAS, substituting a well for a water line effected considerable savings from  
17 a project at the Durham County Prison Unit; and

18 WHEREAS, reduction in costs have been effected through elimination of  
19 unnecessary projects and economies in construction of others, and have resulted in there being  
20 available unallocated Capital Improvement funds available for necessary Prison Department  
21 projects; and

22 WHEREAS, there is great need for construction of other projects not heretofore  
23 authorized, and for which funds can be made available through transfer of funds from existing  
24 appropriations to new appropriations for capital improvements: Now, therefore

25  
26 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

28 **Section 1.** The Director of the Budget is hereby authorized to transfer forty-seven  
29 thousand dollars (\$47,000.00) from funds appropriated in 1963 for the construction of a water  
30 line at Unit 051, Durham County, eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$88,000.00) appropriated in  
31 1963 for construction of a 100-man dormitory at Caledonia Prison, nine hundred five thousand  
32 dollars (\$905,000.00) appropriated in 1963 for renovation and enlargement of Unit 024, Greene  
33 County, one hundred sixty-six thousand dollars (\$166,000.00) appropriated in 1963 for  
34 renovation and enlargement of Unit 132, Burke County, two hundred seventy-six thousand  
35 dollars (\$276,000.00) appropriated in 1963 for renovation of Craggy Prison, and one hundred  
36 thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) received from the sale of prison land to a separate Capital  
37 Improvement account, five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) of which may be used for  
38 construction of such new prison unit, or for the renovation and repair of such existing prison  
39 unit as may be deemed necessary in the discretion of the Governor and the Advisory Budget  
40 Commission, and the balance of said account shall revert and be paid into the General Fund of  
41 the State.

43 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

**Sec. 3.** This Act shall be effective from and after its ratification.
