April 7, 1989 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM BENEFITS PAYABLE FOR THE 3 TREATMENT OF CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY UNDER THE TEACHERS' AND 4 STATE EMPLOYEES' COMPREHENSIVE MAJOR MEDICAL PLAN. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 135-40.7A(b) reads as rewritten: 6 "(b) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Part, the maximum benefit for each 7 covered individual for treatment of chemical dependency is as follows: 9 30 Consecutive Days \$ 3.900 Fiscal Year 10 6.500 \$ 8,000 Lifetime  $\frac{20,000}{}$ 25,000 Daily benefits are limited to one hundred thirty dollars (\$130.00) two hundred 12 dollars (\$200.00) except for medical detoxification treatment under rules established by 13 the Executive Administrator and Board of Trustees." 14 15 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
