6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 41-2 reads as rewritten:

8 "§ 41-2. Survivorship in joint tenancy abolished; proviso as to partnership.

In all estates, real or personal, held in joint tenancy, the part or share of any tenant 9 dying shall not descend or go to the surviving tenant, but shall descend or be vested in 10 the heirs, executors, or administrators, respectively, of the tenant so dying, in the same 11 manner as estates held by tenancy in common: Provided, that estates held in joint 12 tenancy for the purpose of carrying on and promoting trade and commerce, or any 13 useful work or manufacture, established and pursued with a view of profit to the parties 14 therein concerned, are vested in the surviving partner, in order to enable him to settle 15 and adjust the partnership business, or pay off the debts which may have been 16 contracted in pursuit of the joint business; but as soon as the same is effected, the 17 survivor shall account with, and pay, and deliver to the heirs, executors and 18 administrators respectively of such deceased partner all such part, share, and sums of 19 money as he may be entitled to by virtue of the original agreement, if any, or according 20 21 to his share or part in the joint concern, in the same manner as partnership stock is usually settled between joint merchants and the representatives of their deceased 22 partners. Nothing in this section prevents the creation of a joint tenancy with right of 23

- 1 <u>survivorship if the instrument creating the joint tenancy expressly provides for a right of</u>
- 2 survivorship, and no other document shall be necessary to establish said right of 3 survivorship."
 - Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
