The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 131E-158(a) reads as rewritten: 6 Every ambulance when transporting a patient on an emergency mission-shall be 7 occupied at a minimum by the following: At least one emergency medical technician who shall be responsible 9 (1) for the medical aspects of the mission prior to arrival at the medical 10 facility, assuming no other individual of higher certification or license is available; and 12 One ambulance attendant who is responsible for the operation of the 13 (2) vehicle and rendering assistance to the emergency medical technician." 14 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
