Se	ection 1. G.S. 20-140.4 reads as rewritten:		
"§ 20-140.4.	Special provisions for motorcycles and mopeds.		
"(a) N	o person shall operate a motorcycle or moped upon a highway or public		
vehicular are	ea:		
(1) When the number of persons upon such motorcycle <u>or moped</u> , including the operator, shall exceed the number of persons which it was designed to carry.		
(2	Unless the operator and all passengers thereon wear safety helmets of a type approved by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles.		
(b) V	iolation of any provision of this section shall not be considered negligence		
per se or cor	ntributory negligence per se in any civil action.		
(c) <u>A</u>	ny person convicted of violating this section shall have committed an		
infraction ar	nd shall be fined according to G.S. 20-135 2A(e) and (f)."		

Sec. 2. The act shall be effective October 1, 1989.
