3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 163-2 reads as rewritten:

## 5 "§ 163-2. Hours of primaries and elections.

In all primaries, general elections, special elections, and referenda held in this State, 6 including those held in and for municipalities and special districts, the polls shall be 7 open at 6:30 A.M., and shall be closed at 7:30 P.M.: Provided, however, that at all voting 8 places at which voting machines are used the responsible county board of elections may permit 9 the polls to remain open until 8:30 P.M.; Provided, however, that the State Board of 10 Elections may provide that all polls in the State shall remain open until 8:30 P.M., by 11 action of the State Board of Elections taken at least two weeks before the election to 12 which the closing hour shall apply. The State Board of Elections may take such action 13 14 only: Upon a finding by the State Board of Elections that there is a need to 15 (1)extend the voting hours in order to accommodate an expected heavy 16 17 voter turnout: or Upon the request of at least five county boards of elections, made after 18 (2)the close of registration for the election." 19 This act shall become effective with respect to primaries and 20

20 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective with respect to primaries and 21 elections held on or after September 1, 1989.
