A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO EXTEND THE SEASON FOR HUNTING BEAR IN CERTAIN AREAS  
2 OF GATES COUNTY.  
3

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. The season for hunting black bears during 1990 shall be from the  
6 second Monday in November to the following Saturday, both days inclusive, in the  
7 following areas of Gates County:

8 (1) That portion of Gates County within a line beginning with the  
9 intersection of N.C. Highway 32 and the Virginia state line; thence  
10 south along N.C. Highway 32 to its intersection with State Road 1002;  
11 thence south along State Road 1002 to its intersection with the  
12 Perquimans County line; thence east along the Perquimans County line  
13 to its intersection with the Pasquotank County line; thence north along  
14 the Pasquotank County line to its intersection with the Camden County  
15 line; thence northwest along the Camden County line to its intersection  
16 with the Virginia state line; thence west along the Virginia state line to  
17 the point of origin;

18 (2) That portion of Gates County within a line beginning at the  
19 intersection of N.C. Highway 13/158 and the Hertford County line;  
20 thence northeast along N.C. Highway 13/158 to its intersection with  
21 N.C. Highway 137; thence east along N.C. Highway 137 to its  
22 intersection with N.C. Highway 37; thence southeast along N.C.  
23 Highway 37 to its intersection with the Chowan County line; thence  
24 southwest along the Chowan County line to its intersection with the

1 Hertford County line; thence northwest along the Hertford County line  
2 to the point of origin.

3 Sec. 2. The seasons for hunting black bears in the areas of Gates County  
4 described in Section 1 in 1991 and succeeding years shall be for at least six days, as  
5 established by the Wildlife Resources Commission.

6 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective October 1, 1990.
