## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF DURHAM TO REOUIRE 3

DEVELOPMENT PLANS DURING THE PROPERTY REZONING PROCESS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4

Section 1. (a) Development Plans and Site Plans. In exercising the zoning power 5 granted to counties by G.S. 153A-340, G.S. 153A-341, and G.S. 153A-342, the Durham 6 County Board of Commissioners may require a development plan showing the proposed 7 development of property be submitted along with any request for the rezoning of that 8 property. The Board may consider the development plan in its deliberations on the 9 rezoning action. The Board may require that any site plan submitted after the rezoning 10 action conform with the previously approved development plans for the same property. 11 The Board may adopt procedures and guidelines for the preparation and presentation of 12 these development plans. 13

The Durham County Board of Commissioners may require that a site plan be 14 (b)15 submitted and approved prior to the issuance of any building permit. The Board may specify the information to be included in a site plan and may require that the site plan be 16 prepared by a professional engineer, architect, surveyor, or landscape architect licensed 17 to practice in North Carolina. The Board may adopt procedures for the preparation and 18 review of the site plans to insure that development of property shall conform to 19 applicable zoning and building laws and regulations. The Board may require that site 20 21 plans conform with previously approved development plans for the same property.
