2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO EXPAND THE ELECTRONIC
3	SURVEILLANCE AND INTENSIVE SUPERVISION PROGRAMS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
6	Correction the sum of \$4,843,172 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to expand the electronic
7	surveillance program by adding 2,000 slots for State offenders on probation and parole
8	and 1,000 slots for offenders supervised by local officials.
9	Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
10	Correction the sum of \$7,462,663 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to expand the intensive
11	supervision program by 3,038 slots.
12	Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
