Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina		
Hazardous Waste Management Commission the sum of \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal		
year to be used for the Commission to revise its rules, procedures, and site selection		
process so that they are consistent with the provisions of Section 1 of this act.		

Sec. 3. Section 1 of this act is effective upon ratification and applies to any hazardous waste facility proposed to be sited or sited but not placed into operation pursuant to Chapter 130B of the General Statutes on or after that date. Section 2 of this act shall become effective 1 July 1990.
