Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: 7 **"§ 136-18.6. Cutting down trees.** The Department shall not cut down trees unless: 8 9 The trees pose an imminent danger to persons or property; or (1) The cutting down of the trees is approved by the appropriate District (2) 10 Engineer." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. 12
