The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 4 5 section to read: "§ 14-32.3. Felonious assault inflicting extremely serious injury; punishment. 6 For purposes of this section, extremely serious injury means injury resulting 7 (a) 8 <u>in:</u> 9 **(1)** Permanent physical handicap or disability to another person; or Protracted hospitalization of another person. 10 Any person who assaults another person and inflicts extremely serious injury 11 shall be punished as a Class H felon." 12 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989, and shall apply to 13 14 offenses occurring on or after that date.
