A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TIME BY WHICH THE MINIMUM WAGE MAY BE RAISED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 95-25.3(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Every employer shall pay to each employee who in any work week performs any work, wages of at least two dollars and seventy-five cents (\$2.75) per hour effective July 1, 1979, two dollars and ninety cents (\$2.90) per hour effective July 1, 1980, three dollars and ten cents (\$3.10) per hour effective January 1, 1982 and three dollars and thirty-five cents (\$3.35) per hour effective January 1, 1983 except as authorized below. If before ~~June 1, 1989~~ June 1, 1991, the minimum wage set forth in the Fair Labor Standards Act is increased above three dollars and thirty-five cents (\$3.35) per hour, the minimum wage required under this section shall increase by the same amount, but shall not increase above four dollars (\$4.00) per hour, effective the same date the increase under the Fair Labor Standards Act is effective."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
