A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR ADDITIONAL SUPPORT OF THE RESIDENTIAL SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMS OPERATED BY THE OFFICE OF RURAL EDUCATION, WESTERN CAROLINA UNIVERSITY AND BY THE RURAL EDUCATION INSTITUTE, EAST CAROLINA UNIVERSITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year, and the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) each fiscal year to be allocated to the Office of Rural Education, Western Carolina University, and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) each fiscal year to be allocated to the Rural Education Institute, East Carolina University, for additional support of the residential summer school programs established by Chapter 757 of the 1985 Session Laws and operated by the Office of Rural Education and the Rural Education Institute.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
