2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA RADIO
3	READING SERVICES.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina
6	Association of Radio Reading Services the sum of two hundred thousand dollars
7	(\$200,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to expand radio reading services in North
8	Carolina, which provide reading services to the blind and visually impaired in North
9	Carolina. These funds shall be allocated as follows:
10	(1) One hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000) to expand the four
11	existing North Carolina Radio Reading Services in terms of increasing
12	local broadcasting hours and the number of listeners served. These
13	Services are:
14	a. Western North Carolina Radio Reading Service, Inc.;
15	b. CPCC Radio, in Charlotte;
16	c. Radio Reading Service, Inc., in Raleigh; and
17	d. Southeastern North Carolina Radio Reading Service, in
18	Fayetteville.
19	(2) Forty thousand dollars $($40,000)$ to encourage the creation of radio
20	reading services in areas presently not being served in North Carolina.
21	Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
