A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT, AFTER JANUARY 1, 1991, THE SALE OR
3 DISTRIBUTION OF ANY PRODUCT PACKAGED IN A CONTAINER OR
4 PACKING MATERIAL MANUFACTURED WITH FULLY HALOGENATED
5 CHLOROFLUOROCARBONS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes is amended by
8 adding a subsection as follows:

9 "**§ 130A-295.2. Chlorofluorocarbon packaging prohibited.**

10 After January 1, 1991, no person shall distribute, sell, or expose for sale in this State,
11 any product packaged in a container or packaging material manufactured with fully
12 halogenated chlorofluorocarbons."

13 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
