A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF AGING TO SUBMIT TO THE
2 GENERAL ASSEMBLY A REGULARLY UPDATED PLAN FOR SERVING
3 OLDER ADULTS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Division of Aging, Department of Human Resources shall
7 submit to the General Assembly by March 1 of every odd-numbered year, beginning
8 March 1, 1991, a Plan for Serving Older Adults. This Plan shall include:

9 (1) A detailed analysis of the needs of older adults in North Carolina, based
10 on existing available data, including demographic geographic health, social,
11 economical, and other pertinent indicators;

12 (2) A clear statement of the goals of the State's long-term public policy on
13 aging;

14 (3) An analysis of services currently provided and an analysis of additional
15 services needed; and

16 (4) Specific implementation recommendations on expansion and funding of
17 current and additional services and services levels.

18 No additional appropriations are required by this act.

19 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
