A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DEFINE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF STEM IN  
GRANVILLE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 183, Private Laws of 1911, is rewritten to  
read:

"Sec. 2. The corporate limits of the town, until changed in accordance with law, are  
as follows:

BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of the intersection of SR 1126 (Range Road) and  
SR 1137(Little Mountain Road) and traveling South 9,340 feet thence Northeast on the  
southside of SR 1104 (Old Hwy 75) for 1,056 feet thence Eastsoutheast on the west side  
of SR 1124 (Otha Mangum Road) for 10,032 feet thence Northeast on the west side of  
SR 1215 (West Lyon Station Road) for 4,224 feet thence Southeast on the west side of  
SR 1127 (Brogden Road) for 2,640 feet thence Northeast on the north side of I-85  
(Interstate 85) for 14,256 feet thence Northwest on the west side of SR 1132 (Saunders  
Road) for 10,560 feet thence Northnortheast on the northwest side of SR 1136  
(Cemetery Road) for 8,448 feet thence South on the east side of Sr 1004 (Old Hwy 75)  
for 1,056 feet thence West on the northside of SR 1137 (Little Mountain Road) for  
5,280 feet, to return to the point of beginning. This area includes 2,560 square acres,  
more or less."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective June 30, 1989.
