OPERATING IN NORTH CAROLINA.	
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
Section 1. G.S. 53-227 reads as rewritten:	
"§ 53-227. Registration of bank holding companies.	
Every bank holding company, not later than July 1, 1985, or within 180 days after	
becoming a bank holding company controlling a North Carolina federally or State-	
chartered bank or banks, or within 180 days after acquiring control, directly or	

indirectly, over a nonbank subsidiary or subsidiaries having offices located in this State

shall register with the Commissioner on forms approved-supplied by the Commissioner."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
