A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE TAKING OF FOXES IN ALAMANCE COUNTY.
- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 4 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open 5 season for taking foxes with weapons during the season for taking rabbits as established 6 by regulation by the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission.
- Sec. 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season
 for taking foxes by trapping from January 2 through January 31 of each year.
- 9 Sec. 3. A season bag limit of 30 applies in the aggregate to all foxes taken 10 during the weapons and trapping seasons established in this act.
- 11 Sec. 4. The Wildlife Resources Commission shall provide for the sale of 12 foxes taken lawfully pursuant to this act.

- Sec. 5. This act shall apply only to Alamance County.
- Sec. 6. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
