A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
TO CONTINUE TO OPERATE A MODIFIED FULL-TIME OFFICE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 163-67(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) In counties which have less than ~~14,001~~18,001 registered voters the State Board of Elections shall prescribe reasonable regulations permitting such counties to operate a modified full-time office to the extent that the operation of such full-time office will not necessarily be required to be open such as is required in counties with total registered voters in excess of ~~14,000~~18,000; provided, that nothing herein shall preclude such counties from maintaining office hours for registration consistent with the hours observed by all other offices within said county."

Sec. 2. This act applies to Transylvania County only.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
