A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO LIMIT THE HEIGHT OF STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF LONG BEACH, AND TO MODIFY A SIMILAR EXISTING ACT FOR THE TOWN OF 3 HOLDEN BEACH. 4 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 1019, Session Laws of 1987, reads as 6 7 rewritten: "Section 1. Except as provided in Section 2 of this act or an ordinance adopted by 8 the town council under Chapter 160A of the General Statutes and approved in a referendum 9 as provided by Section 2.1 of this act, no building erected within the corporate limits of 10 any town, as defined in G.S. 160A-1, after the effective date of this act may have a 11 height in excess of 35 feet above ground level." 12 Sec. 2. Chapter 1019 of the 1987 Session Laws is amended by adding a new 13 section to read: 14 15 "Sec. 2.1. (a) (a)The height limitation contained in Section 1 of this act may be increased within any town with the approval by the qualified voters of that town in a 16 referendum of an ordinance to increase the limit. The referendum may be called only 17 by the governing body of the town. 18 19 A proposition to approve an ordinance under this section shall be printed on (b)20 the ballot in substantially the following form: 'Shall the ordinance (describe the effect of the ordinance) be approved? 21 22 []YES

2 Sec. 3. Section 3 of Chapter 1019 of the 1987 Session Laws reads as 3 rewritten:

- 4 "Sec. 3. This act applies to the <u>Town-Towns</u> of Holden Beach <u>and Long Beach</u> 5 only."
 - Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
