A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE SCIENCE MUSEUMS OF
CHARLOTTE, INC., IN MECKLENBURG COUNTY FOR CAPITAL
EXPENDITURES FOR DISCOVERY PLACE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Science

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Science Museums of Charlotte, Inc., in Mecklenburg County the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year, to be matched with local funds at the rate of three dollars (\$3.00) of local funds for every one dollar (\$1.00) of State funds, to be used for capital expenditures at Discovery Place in Charlotte.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
