A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL FEE PAID BY PERSONS LICENSED TO
2 CONSTRUCT AND PERSONS WHO OPERATE NUCLEAR FACILITIES TO
3 THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL
4 RESOURCES FOR PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTING EMERGENCY
5 RESPONSE ACTIVITIES.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. G.S. 166A-6.1(b) reads as rewritten:

9 "(b) Every person, firm, corporation or municipality who is licensed to construct
10 or who is operating a fixed nuclear facility for the production of electricity shall pay to
11 the State of North Carolina for use of the Department of Environment, Health, and
12 Natural Resources an annual fee of no more than ~~twelve~~eighteen thousand dollars
13 ~~(\$12,000)~~(\$18,000) for each fixed nuclear facility which is located within this State or
14 has a Plume Exposure Pathway Emergency Planning Zone of which any part is located
15 within this State. This fee is to be used to assist in or partially defray such costs of
16 planning and implementing emergency response activities as are required by the Federal
17 Emergency Management Agency for the operation of nuclear facilities. Said fee is to be
18 paid no later than July 31 of each year. The amount of the fee for use by the Department
19 of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall be determined by such
20 Department. The fee will be referred to the Department of Crime Control and Public
21 Safety for collection."

22 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990. ♦
