A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO
ESTABLISH TWENTY NEW SBI AGENT POSITIONS, TO FUND SEVEN NEW
POSITIONS IN THE SPECIAL PROSECUTION DIVISION, TO COMPLETI
IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DARE PROGRAM STATEWIDE, AND TO
ASSIST WITH THE EXPENSES OF COORDINATING
MULTIJURISDICTIONAL TASK FORCES.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
Justice the sum of \$2,145,928 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:
(1) \$1,536,620 to fund 20 new agent positions in the State Bureau of
Investigation;
(2) \$415,156 to fund five additional attorney positions and two support
staff positions in the Special Prosecution Division to prosecute drug
violations;
(3) \$184,852 to complete implementation of the DARE program
statewide;
(4) \$9,300 to assist with expenses of coordinating local, State, and federal
law enforcement agencies in multijurisdictional task forces.
Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1000
