A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXPAND THE LIST OF OFFICES AND DEPARTMENTS  
RECEIVING SUMMER INTERNS ALLOCATED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA  
INTERNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143B-417 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 143B-417. North Carolina Internship Council – creation; powers and duties.**

There is hereby created the North Carolina Internship Council of the Department of Administration. The North Carolina Internship Council shall have the following functions and duties:

- (1) To determine the number of student interns to be allocated to each of the following offices or departments:
  - a. Office of the Governor
  - b. Department of Administration
  - c. Department of Correction
  - d. Department of Cultural Resources
  - e. Department of Revenue
  - f. Department of Transportation
  - g. Department of Natural Resources and Community Development
  - h. Department of Commerce
  - i. Department of Crime Control and Public Safety
  - j. Department of Human Resources

2 l. Office of the Secretary of State  
3 m. Office of the State Auditor  
4 n. Office of the State Treasurer  
5 o. Department of Public Education

8 q. Department of Agriculture  
9 r. Department of Labor  
10 s. Department of Insurance  
11 t. Office of the Speaker of the House of Representatives

17 (2) To screen applications for student internships and select from these  
18 applications the recipients of student internships; and  
19 (3) To determine the appropriateness of proposals for projects for student  
20 interns submitted by the offices and departments enumerated in (1)."  
21 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
