2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF ETHNIC HARASSMENT IN
3	PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding the following subsection at
6	the end:
7	"(33) Local boards of education shall adopt policies forbidding students and school
8	personnel, while on school property or while participating in school activities, from
9	engaging in violence, vandalism, threats, harassment, or intimidation based upon race,
10	religion, or ethnicity. These policies shall specify disciplinary measures to be taken
11	against persons who engage in such activities. These policies shall also establish
12	procedures to be followed by school officials in responding to such incidents.
13	Local boards of eductation shall publish all the policies mandated by this subsection
14	and make them available to all school personnel and to each student and his parent or
15	guardian at the beginning of each school year."
16	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
