1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF ALCOHOLIC REHABILITATION
3 CENTERS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 122C-181(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Secretary shall
7 operate the following facilities:

8 (1) For the mentally ill:

- 9 a. Cherry Hospital;
- 10 b. Dorothea Dix Hospital;
- 11 c. John Umstead Hospital; and
- 12 d. Broughton Hospital; and

13 (2) For the mentally retarded:

- 14 a. Caswell Center;
- 15 b. O'Berry Center;
- 16 c. Murdoch Center;
- 17 d. Western Carolina Center; and
- 18 e. Black Mountain Center; and

19 (3) For substance abusers:

- 20 a. Walter B. Jones Alcoholic Rehabilitation Alcohol and Drug
21 Abuse Treatment Center;
- 22 b. Alcoholic Rehabilitation Alcohol and Drug Abuse Treatment
23 Center at Butner; and

1 c. ~~Alcoholic Rehabilitation~~ Alcohol and Drug Abuse Treatment
2 Center at Black Mountain; and

3 (4) As special care facilities:

4 a. Wilson Special Care Center;

5 b. Whitaker School; and

6 c. Wright School."

7 Sec. 2. G.S. 143-117 reads as rewritten:

8 **"§ 143-117. Institutions included.**

9 All persons admitted to the following institutions operated by the Department of
10 Human Resources are required to pay the actual cost of their care, treatment, training
11 and maintenance at these institutions: regional psychiatric hospitals, special care
12 centers, regional mental retardation centers, schools for emotionally disturbed children,
13 and ~~alcoholic rehabilitation~~ alcohol and drug abuse treatment centers."

14 Sec. 3. G.S. 143-117.1 reads as rewritten:

15 **"§ 143-117.1. Definitions.**

16 As used in this Article, the following terms have the meaning specified unless the
17 content clearly implies otherwise:

18 (1) 'Care' means care, treatment, training, maintenance, habilitation and
19 rehabilitation of a person admitted to institutions covered by this
20 Article.

21 (2) 'Department' means the Department of Human Resources.

22 (3) 'Persons admitted' means clients of regional psychiatric hospitals,
23 State special care centers, regional mental retardation centers, schools
24 for emotionally disturbed children, and ~~alcoholic rehabilitation~~ centers,
25 alcohol and drug abuse treatment centers, including clients who may
26 be treated on an outpatient basis.

27 (4) 'Secretary' means the Secretary of Human Resources."

28 Sec. 4. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
