- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 Section 1. G.S. 49-14(b) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) Proof of paternity pursuant to this section shall be beyond a reasonable doubt<u>by</u> 7 clear, cogent and convincing evidence. A judgment of nonpaternity pursuant to this 8 section shall be a bar to a prosecution in a criminal action pursuant to G.S. 49-2 to 9 establish paternity between the child and putative father."

10 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989, and applies to cases 11 arising on or after that date.
