A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO MAKE ETHNIC INTIMIDATION A CRIME.
- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 4 Section 1. Article 8 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 5 section to read:
- 6 "§ 14-32.3. Ethnic Intimidation.
- 7 If any person shall, because of race, religion, or ethnicity, injure another person, or
- 8 <u>damage or deface the property of another person, or threaten to do any such acts, he</u>
 9 shall be punished as a Class G felon."
- 10 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989, and shall apply to 11 offenses occurring on or after that date.
