A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MAKE CHANGES IN THE PRACTICE OF FUNERAL SERVICE ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 90-210.28 reads as rewritten:

"§ 90-210.28. Fees.

The Board may set and collect fees, not to exceed the following amounts:

Establishment permit

Application ~~\$200.00~~ \$250.00

Annual renewal ~~400.00~~ 175.00

Late renewal penalty ~~75.00~~ 100.00

Establishment reinspection fee 100.00

Courtesy card

Application 75.00

Annual renewal 50.00

Out-of-state licensee

Embalmer, funeral director,

funeral service

Application—North

Carolina-Resident ~~400.00~~ 150.00

12 The Board shall provide, without charge, one copy of the current statutes and
13 regulations relating to Mortuary Science to every person applying for and paying the
14 appropriate fees for licensing pursuant to this Article. The Board may charge all others
15 requesting copies of the current statutes and regulations, and the licensees or applicants
16 requesting additional copies, a fee equal to the costs of production and distribution of
17 the requested documents."
