A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO INCREASE THE SENTENCE FOR ENGAGING IN A CONTINUING
CRIMINAL ENTERPRISE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 90-95.1(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Any person who engages in a continuing criminal enterprise shall be punished as a Class ~~C~~B felon and in addition shall be subject to the forfeiture prescribed in subsection (b) of this section."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989, and shall apply to offenses occurring on or after that date.
