4	STATE EMPLOYEES' COMPREHENSIVE MAJOR MEDICAL PLAN.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 135-40.7A(b) reads as rewritten:
7	"(b) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Part, the maximum benefit for each
8	covered individual for treatment of chemical dependency is as follows:
9	<del>30 Consecutive Days</del> \$3,900
10	Fiscal Year <u>6,500</u> <u>\$ 8,000</u>
11	Lifetime <u>-20,000</u> <u>25,000</u>
12	Daily benefits are limited to one hundred thirty dollars (\$130.00) two hundred dollars
13	(\$200.00) except for medical detoxification treatment under rules established by the
14	Executive Administrator and Board of Trustees."
15	Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
