A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM BENEFITS PAYABLE FOR THE TREATMENT OF CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY UNDER THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' COMPREHENSIVE MAJOR MEDICAL PLAN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 135-40.7A(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Part, the maximum benefit for each covered individual for treatment of chemical dependency is as follows:

30 Consecutive Days	\$ 3,900		
Fiscal Year		6,500	<u>\$ 8,000</u>
Lifetime	20,000	<u>25,000</u>	

Daily benefits are limited to ~~one hundred thirty dollars (\$130.00)~~ two hundred dollars (\$200.00) except for medical detoxification treatment under rules established by the Executive Administrator and Board of Trustees."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
