The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4 Section 1. G.S. 110-86(2) reads as rewritten: 5 'Child Day Care' means any child care arrangement except seasonal 6 "(2)recreational programs operated for less than four consecutive months in a year, wherein three or more children less than 13 years old receive care away from their own home by persons other than their parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters, first 9 cousins, guardians or full-time custodians, or in the child's own home where other 10 unrelated children are in care." 11

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
