The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. North Carolina shall remain a member of the Southeast Interstate Low-level Radioactive Waste Management Compact if, on or before June 30, 1989: The Compact is amended to exclude any member which adopts and (1) maintains rules or regulations regarding air and water quality control 9 that are more strict than the United States Environmental Protection 10 Agency standards and that adversely affect the economy of the State of North Carolina; and 12 The Compact is amended to exclude any member which prohibits the 13 (2) use of its hazardous waste facility by another member state. 14 Otherwise, on July 1, 1989, Chapter 104F of the General Statutes is repealed and a copy of this act shall be delivered to the Southeast Interstate Low-level Radioactive Waste 16 Management Commission. 17 18 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
