Referred to: Judiciary III. April 19, 1991 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE JUST COMPENSATION PROCEDURES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Chapter 40A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 40A-70. Just compensation for landowners and others. Any municipality, county government, or other political subdivision of this State which makes a previously conforming use of property nonconforming must either allow the existing use to continue or compensate the owner of the interest for the termination of such right. The phasing out of nonconforming uses through amortization is expressly prohibited." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to all uses of

property which have not been eliminated on the ratification date.
