A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A SINGLE COUNTY TO ORGANIZE A WATER AND  
2 SEWER AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 162A OF THE GENERAL  
3 STATUTES.  
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5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 162A-3(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) The governing body of a single county or the governing bodies of any two or  
8 more political subdivisions may by resolution signify their determination to organize an  
9 authority under the provisions of this Article. Each of such resolutions shall be adopted  
10 after a public hearing thereon, notice of which hearing shall be given by publication at  
11 least once, not less than 10 days prior to the date fixed for such hearing, in a newspaper  
12 having a general circulation in the political subdivision. Such notice shall contain a brief  
13 statement of the substance of the proposed resolution, shall set forth the proposed  
14 articles of incorporation of the authority and shall state the time and place of the public  
15 hearing to be held thereof. No such political subdivision shall be required to make any  
16 other publication of such resolution under the provisions of any other law."

17 Sec. 2. G.S. 162A-3.1(a) reads as rewritten:

18 "(a) As an alternative to the procedure set forth in G.S. 162A-3, the governing  
19 body of a single county or the governing bodies of any two or more political  
20 subdivisions may by resolution signify their determination to organize an authority  
21 under the provisions of this section of this Article. Each of such resolutions shall be  
22 adopted after a public hearing thereon, notice of which hearing shall be given by  
23 publication at least once, not less than 10 days prior to the date fixed for such hearing,  
24 in a newspaper having a general circulation in the political subdivision. Such notice

1 shall contain a brief statement of the substance of the proposed resolution, shall set forth  
2 the proposed articles of incorporation of the authority and shall state the time and place  
3 of the public hearing. No such political subdivision shall be required to make any other  
4 publication of such resolution under the provisions of any other law."

5           Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
