A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO WAIVE THE TWELVE-MONTH DURATIONAL REQUIREMENT FOR RESIDENT TUITION STATUS FOR TEACHERS ENROLLED IN COURSES TO COMPLETE CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 116-143.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(m) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, determination of status as a resident for tuition purposes under this section shall be made without applying the 12-month durational requirement to any noncertificated teacher employed by a local school administrative unit and enrolled in courses to complete certification requirements of the State Board of Education. For purposes of this subsection "noncertificated" shall mean provisionally certified to teach for the first time in a local school administrative unit and not possessing any other level of certificate."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective August 1, 1992.
