A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
STUDY DOMICILIARY CARE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) The Legislative Research Commission may study the domiciliary care system in its entirety.

(b) The Commission may include as the subjects of its study:

- (1) The purpose of domiciliary care;
- (2) Where domiciliary care fits in the continuum of long-term care services in North Carolina;
- (3) Domiciliary care rate setting;
- (4) Policy and procedures of current operating cost reporting;
- (5) Funding distribution ratios for federal, State, and county government; and
- (6) Eligibility requirements for special assistance in contrast to eligibility requirements for Medicare and Medicaid.

(c) The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations, including recommendations for needed legislation, to the 1994 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
