—-ONSLOW MUSEUM FUNDS/NEW PURPOSE

Sec. 14.1. Funds appropriated in Section 2 of Chapter 830 of the 1987 Session Laws to the Office of State Budget for a grant-in-aid to the Onslow County Commissioners to assist in relocating the Onslow County Museum from Richlands to Jacksonville may be used by the Onslow County Commissioners for construction of new museum facilities. Unless the Onslow County Commissioners adopt a resolution on or before September 30, 1992 allowing these funds to be used for the construction of new museum facilities instead of for relocating the Onslow County Museum, then these funds shall revert to the General Fund on October 1, 1992."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
