1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE APPROPRIATIONS AND BUDGET REVENUE ACT  
2 OF 1991 TO AUTHORIZE THE ONSLOW COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO  
3 USE UNEXPENDED GRANT-IN-AID FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR A  
4 DIFFERENT BUT RELATED PURPOSE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Chapter 689 of the 1991 Session Laws is amended by adding the  
8 following new section to read:

10 ~~—~~ONSLOW MUSEUM FUNDS/NEW PURPOSE

11 Sec. 14.1. Funds appropriated in Section 2 of Chapter 830 of the 1987  
12 Session Laws to the Office of State Budget for a grant-in-aid to the Onslow County  
13 Commissioners to assist in relocating the Onslow County Museum from Richlands to  
14 Jacksonville may be used by the Onslow County Commissioners for construction of  
15 new museum facilities. Unless the Onslow County Commissioners adopt a resolution  
16 on or before September 30, 1992 allowing these funds to be used for the construction of  
17 new museum facilities instead of for relocating the Onslow County Museum, then these  
18 funds shall revert to the General Fund on October 1, 1992."

19 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
