

1 Trustees of the constituent institutions, from the eastern region of the
2 State.

3 (3) Three members appointed by the Governor, at least one of whom is a
4 former member of one of the Boards of Trustees of one of the
5 constituent institutions from the western region of the State.

6 The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the
7 Senate shall each designate one of their appointees as cochair of the Commission. The
8 Commission shall have its initial meeting on the call of the cochairs. The initial
9 meeting shall be held on or before August 31, 1992.

10 Sec. 3. Members appointed to the Commission shall serve until the
11 Commission makes its final report. Vacancies on the Commission shall be filled in the
12 same manner as the original appointments.

13 Sec. 4. Upon the request of the Commission, or its staff, the Board of
14 Governors of The University of North Carolina, the Boards of Trustees and the
15 administrations of the constituent institutions, as well as all other State departments and
16 agencies, shall furnish to the Commission or its staff any information in their possession
17 or available to them.

18 Sec. 5. The Commission shall submit a report of its findings and
19 recommendations to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee and the
20 General Assembly on or before January 15, 1993. Reports shall be submitted by filing
21 the report with the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro
22 Tempore of the Senate. The Commission shall terminate upon filing its report.

23 Sec. 6. Upon approval of the Legislative Services Commission, the
24 Legislative Administrative Officer shall assign professional and clerical staff to assist in
25 the work of the Commission. Clerical staff shall be furnished to the Commission
26 through the offices of the House and Senate Supervisors of Clerks. The expenses of
27 employment of the clerical staff shall be borne by the Commission. With the prior
28 approval of the Legislative Services Commission, the Study Commission may hold its
29 meetings in the State Legislative Building or the Legislative Office Building.

30 Sec. 7. Members of the Commission shall be paid per diem, subsistence, and
31 travel allowances in accordance with G.S. 120-3.1, 138-5, or 138-6 as appropriate.

32 Sec. 8. There is allocated from the funds appropriated to the General
33 Assembly's Legislative Services Commission to the UNC Governance Commission for
34 its work the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year.

35 Sec. 9. This act is effective July 1, 1992.
