A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A UNIFORM MANDATORY RETIREMENT AGE OF 3 SEVENTY-TWO FOR ALL JUDGES AND JUSTICES OF THE GENERAL
- 4 COURT OF JUSTICE.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 7A-4.20 reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 7A-4.20. Age limit for service as justice or judge: exception.

No justice or judge of the appellate division of the General Court of Justice may 8 9 continue in office beyond the last day of the month in which he attains his seventysecond birthday, and no judge of the superior court or district court division of the 10 General Court of Justice may continue in office beyond the last day of the month in 11 which he attains his seventieth birthday, but justices and judges so retired may be 12 recalled for periods of temporary service as provided in subchapters II and III of this 13 14 chapter." 15

Sec. 2. G.S. 135-57(b) reads as rewritten:

Any member who is a justice or judge of the appellate division of the General 16 "(b) Court of Justice shall be automatically retired as of the first day of the calendar month 17 coinciding with or next following the later of January 1, 1974, or his attainment of his 18 seventy-second birthday and each other member shall be automatically retired as of the 19 20 first day of the calendar month coinciding with or next following the later of January 1, 21 1974, or his attainment of his seventieth birthday; provided, however, that no judge who is a member on January 1, 1974, shall be forced to retire under the provisions of this 22

- 1 subsection at an earlier date than the last day that he is permitted to remain in office
- 2 under the provisions of G.S. 7A-4.20."
- 3 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification, and shall apply to judges or 4 justices retiring on or after that date.
