2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE PAYMENT OF EXCESS DAMAGES AGAINST A STATE
3	EMPLOYEE OR BOARD MEMBER FOR ADMINISTERING AN
4	UNCONSTITUTIONAL GOALS PROGRAM.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Article 31A of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by
7	adding a new section to read:
8	"§ 143-300.10. Payment of excess damages relating to unconstitutional goals
9	program.
10	In an action to which this Article applies, the State shall pay the excess amount of a
11	judgment or settlement under G.S. 143-300.6 for damages against a State employee or
12	member of a State board or commission for enforcing or administering a goals program
13	promoting participation by disadvantaged businesses, minority businesses, and women
14	businesses, in contracts let by a State department or agency that is held unconstitutional.
15	The excess amount is the amount of the judgment or settlement over (i) the limit
16	provided in G.S. 143-300.6(a) and (ii) any coverage under G.S. 58-32-15. This section
17	does not waive the sovereign immunity of the State with respect to any claim."
18	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to any litigation
19	challenging the constitutionality of a goals program and pending before a court on or

20 after the date of ratification.
