2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY LANGUAGE TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL BOARDS OF 3 HEALTH TO ADOPT RULES MORE STRINGENT THAN THE COMMISSION 4 FOR HEALTH SERVICES OR THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT 5 COMMISSION WHEN DEEMED NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH. 6 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 8 Section 1. G.S. 130A-39(b) reads as rewritten: A local board of health may adopt a more stringent rule in an area regulated 9 "(b) by the Commission for Health Services or the Environmental Management Commission 10 where, in the opinion of the local board of health, a more stringent rule is required to 11 protect the public health; A local board of health may adopt by reference rules adopted 12 by the Commission for Health Services or the Environmental Management 13 14 Commission, with any more stringent modifications or additions deemed necessary by the local board of health to protect the public health; otherwise, the rules of the 15 Commission for Health Services or the rules of the Environmental Management 16 Commission shall prevail over local board of health rules. However, a local board of 17 health may not adopt a rule concerning the grading and permitting of food and lodging 18 facilities as listed in Part 6 of Article 8 of this Chapter and a local board of health may 19 adopt rules concerning sanitary sewage collection, treatment and disposal systems 20 which are not designed to discharge effluent to the land surface or surface waters and 21 which are not public or community systems only in accordance with G.S. 130A-335(c)." 22 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. 23
