A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL BOARDS OF HEALTH TO ADOPT BY RULES OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL 3 REFERENCE MANAGEMENT COMMISSION CONCERNING WELLS OR TO ADOPT MORE STRINGENT 4 5 RULES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 Section 1. G.S. 87-96 reads as rewritten: 7 "§ 87-96. Conflict with other laws. 8 The provisions of any law, rule, or local ordinance which establish standards 9 (a) affording greater protection to groundwater resources or public health, safety, or welfare 10 shall prevail, within the jurisdiction to which they apply, over the provisions of this 11 Article and rules adopted pursuant to this Article. 12 13 (b)Rules relating to public health, wells, or groundwater adopted by the Commission for Health Services shall prevail over this Article or rules adopted pursuant to 14 this Article. Article, rules adopted pursuant to this Article, and rules adopted by a local 15 board of health pursuant to subsection (c) of this section. This Article shall not be 16 construed to repeal any law or rule in effect as of July 1, 1989. 17 A local board of health may adopt by reference rules adopted by the 18 (c) Environmental Management Commission pursuant to this Article, and may adopt more 19 stringent rules when necessary to protect the public health. More stringent rules 20 adopted by a local board of health pursuant to this subsection shall prevail over this 21 Article and rules adopted pursuant to this Article." 22
