A BILL TO BE ENTITLED	
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1 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE STATUTES GOVERNING THE CUMBERLAND 2 3 MEMORIAL AUDITORIUM COMMISSION. 4 Whereas, the General Assembly, on April 28, 1965, created the Cumberland Memorial Auditorium Commission to provide the most efficient management and 5 beneficial use and enjoyment of the Cumberland County Auditorium and its facilities; 6 7 and 8 Whereas, there is a need to change the name, organization, and functions of 9 the Cumberland Memorial Auditorium Commission; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 10 Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 360 of the 1965 Session Laws, as amended 11 12 by Section 6 of Chapter 983 of the 1984 Session Laws, reads as rewritten: Cumberland Auditorium-County Civic Center Commission. There is hereby 13 "(a) 14 created in Cumberland County a commission to be known as the Cumberland Memorial Auditorium-County Civic Center Commission which shall have the powers and duties 15 hereinafter set forth. 16 17 Membership; Terms of Office. The Commission shall consist of fifteen (15) (b) members who shall be residents of Cumberland County appointed by the Board of 18 County Commissioners of Cumberland County immediately after the date when this Act 19 20 becomes effective. The Commission shall consist of 16 members. Fifteen members 21 shall be residents of Cumberland County and shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners. The sixteenth member shall be the County Manager of Cumberland 22

1	County who sha	all serve in an ex officio and nonvoting capacity and without limit as to
2	term.	
3	(1)	Five $(5)$ of the first members of the Commission shall be appointed for a term of and (1) year five (5) for a term of two (2) years, and five (5)
4		a term of one (1)-year, five (5)-for a term of two (2)-years, and five (5)
5		for a term of three $(3)$ -years. Upon the expiration of each of the terms,
6		the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint successor members
7		of the Commission who shall each serve for terms of three $(3)$ -years
8		and until their successors are appointed for like terms. Any member of
9		the Commission may be reappointed for successive terms.
10	(2)	Vacancies occurring on the Commission otherwise than by expiration
11		of a term shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term of the
12	( <b>2</b> )	vacant office.
13	(3)	From its membership the Commission shall at its first meeting, and
14		annually thereafter, elect a chairman, vice-chairman, and secretary.
15		<u>Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Secretary.</u> These officers shall hold
16		office for one year or until their successors are duly elected. The
17 18		County Manager of Cumberland County shall by virtue of his office also be the treasurer of the Commission. All funds received or handled by the
19		Commission shall be subject to the control of the treasurer who shall
20		prescribe the way and manner all such funds shall be collected, held,
21		disbursed and accounted for. A yearly budget shall be prepared and
22		submitted to the County Board of Commissioners for approval along with
23		any request for an operation attached levy or any request for public funds to
24		be used in the operation of the auditorium facilities. The Board of County
25		Commissioners shall select the auditor of the Commission's accounts.
26	(4)	The officers elected together with one other member-two other members
27		of the Commission, who will also be elected at the first meeting of the
28		Commission and annually thereafter, shall constitute the Executive
29		Committee of the Commission. In order to provide for the most efficient
30		operation of the business of the Commission, the Executive Committee shall
31 32		have sole power and authority over the management and operation of the facilities and to conduct the Commission's business within the policies as are
33		from time to time adopted by the Commission, and all powers and authority
34		not specifically reserved for action of the full Commission under its bylaws
35		shall be vested in the Executive Committee.—The Executive Committee
36		shall perform those duties and functions specified in the bylaws of the
37		Commission.
38	(5)	Regular meetings of the Commission shall be held quarterly and
39		special monthly. Special meetings may be called by the chairman or
40		any two (2) members of the Executive Committee upon twenty-four 24
41		hours' written notice to the members stating the purpose of the
42		meeting. Chairman or a majority of the voting members of the
43		Commission. Attendance of not less than eight (8) members shall
44		constitute a quorum for the purpose of transaction of business at any
45		regular or special meeting.

16 17	(1)	The establishment and management of a memorial fund as a means by which donations may be solicited, received and used in the
18		construction, equipment, decoration, maintenance or operation of the
19		auditorium, <u>Civic Center</u> , its allied facilities and grounds and
20		appropriate recognition made to the memory of persons to be
21		memorialized.
22	(2)	To assist, in advisory capacity, the Board of County Commissioners in
23 24		planning for and construction of the facility, and carry out any duty or assignment expressly delegated to it by resolution of the Board of
25		County Commissioners.
26	(3)	To operate the public auditorium Civic Center facility under the terms
27		and conditions prescribed by the Board of County Commissioners.
28	(4)	To study, plan, and program for the highest and best use of the
29	(5)	facilities committed to it for public use, edification and enjoyment.
30 31	(5)	The power to make such reasonable rules and regulations for its own proper organization and procedure and the management, use, control,
32		improvement, equipment, upkeep, and safekeeping of the facilities,
33		properties, and funds committed to its charge, including the receipts
34		and expenditures of such funds committed to its charge, including the
35		receipts and expenditures of such funds as may be or become available
36		for the improvement or management thereof and the use of such
37		facilities as well as spectators' or participants' entrance fees and
38		provided such rules and regulations do not conflict with and are not
39 40		inconsistent with the laws of the State of North Carolina or ordinances

26	(4)	Collect, receive, deposit, disburse, or otherwise handle, and account	
27		for all funds only in such manner as is prescribed by the Treasurer	
28		Finance Officer of Cumberland County.	
29	(5)	No member of the Commission shall receive or accept any fee,	
30		gratuity or thing of value in payment for any act to be done or not to be	
31		done by the Commission save and except such salary as may be	
32		prescribed by the Board of County Commissioners.	
33	(6)	Upon dissolution of the Commission or upon termination of its	
34		connection with the operation of the facilities by resolution of the	
35		Board of County Commissioners, all funds and property acquired, held
