2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE GENERAL CONTRACTORS LICENSING BOARD
3	AND THE CODE OFFICIALS QUALIFICATION BOARD TO IMPLEMENT
4	RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE STATE AUDITOR AND TO REPORT
5	IMPLEMENTATION STATUS TO THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION
6	ON GOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Whereas, the Legislative Research Commission undertook to study consumer
9	protection issues, including those relating to the elderly, during the 1989-91 biennium;
10	and
11	Whereas, the consumer protection study revealed, among other things, serious
12	problems and deficiencies relating to regulation and enforcement of business practices
13	in the home construction industry; and
14	Whereas, the LRC Consumer Protection Study Committee requested a State
15	Audit of the performance of boards and commissions established to regulate the home
16	construction industry; and
17	Whereas, the final report of the State Auditor was presented to the Consumer
18	Protection Study Committee at its November 16 meeting; and
19	Whereas, the audit report indicated that although the boards and commissions
20	audited were in compliance with their statutory authority and duties, improvements are
21	needed in the overall regulatory system and in certain board management practices in
22	order to ensure that the general welfare of the consuming public is protected; Now,
23	therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 1

2 Section 1. The General Contractors Licensing Board shall implement all 3 recommendations specifically addressed to the Board in the State Auditor's Performance Audit Report on Regulation of the Home Construction Industry, November, 1990; 4 5 provided that the Board is not required to implement or report on any recommendations 6 in the Auditor's report that are addressed to other agencies included in the audit, or that 7 require action not within the Board's statutory or regulatory authority. The Board shall 8 report to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, not later than 9 October 1, 1991, on the implementation status of the applicable recommendations.

10 Sec. 2. The North Carolina Code Officials Qualification Board shall implement all recommendations specifically addressed to the Board in the State 11 12 Auditor's Performance Audit Report on Regulation of the Home Construction Industry, 13 November, 1990; provided that the Board is not required to implement or report on any 14 recommendations in the Auditor's report that are addressed to other agencies included in 15 the audit, or that require action not within the Board's statutory or regulatory authority. 16 The Board shall report to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental 17 Operations, not later than October 1, 1991, on the implementation status of the 18 applicable recommendations.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
